







MINIMUM NOISE FIGURE, ASSOCIATED GAIN vs. FREQUENCY




MINIMUM NOISE FIGURE, ASSOCIATED GAIN vs. DRAIN CURRENT




DRAIN CURRENT vs.






#### MINIMUM NOISE FIGURE, ASSOCIATED GAIN vs. DRAIN CURRENT



## FLAT-LEAD 4-PIN THIN-TYPE SUPER MINIMOLD (M04) (UNIT: mm)




#### **PIN CONNECTIONS**
